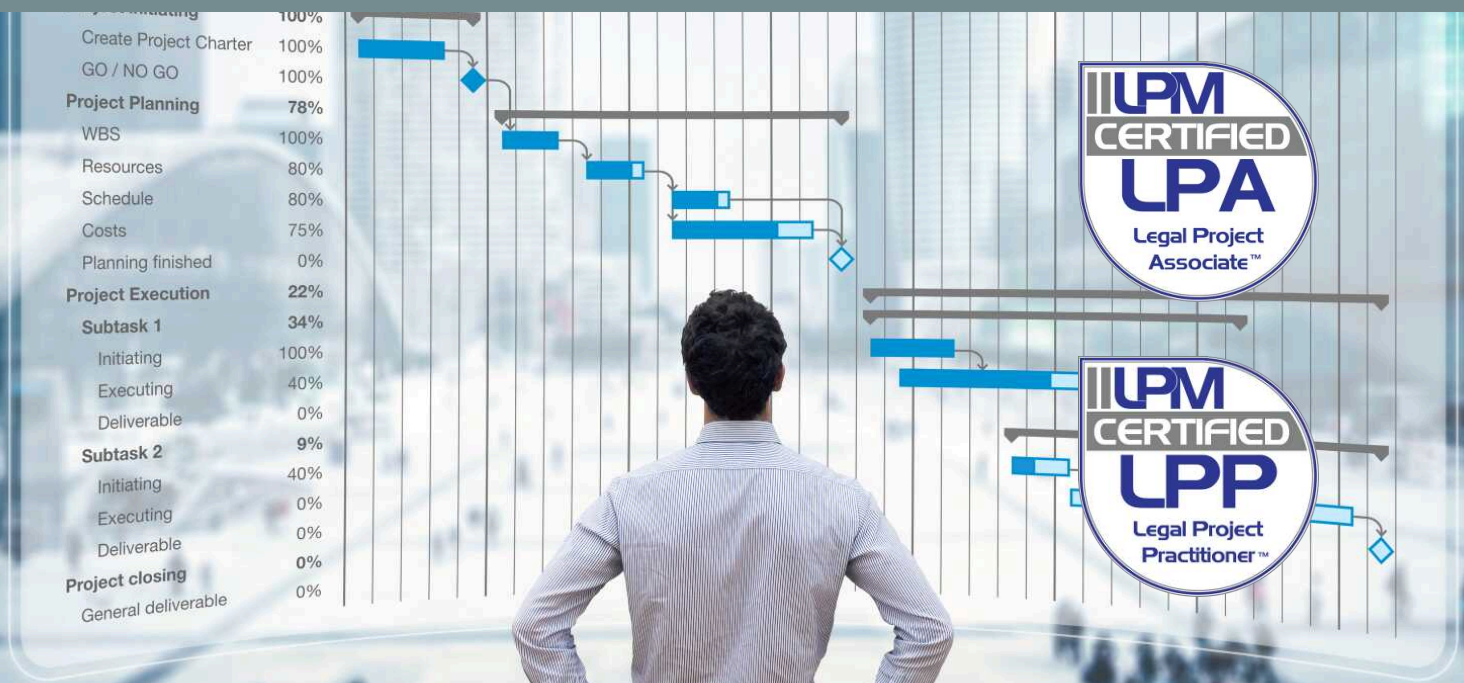

## INTRODUCTION

This is a three-day course, after which students may apply to become Legal Project Practitioners (LPPs), certified by the International Institute of Legal Project Management (IILPM).

Students attending the first two days only are eligible to become certified as Legal Project Associates (LPAs) by the IILPM.

Research shows that practising skills is the most effective way to learn and apply new knowledge. Hence during the course students are taken through facilitated workshops and exercises.

Students particularly enjoy the workshops and exercises, not least because they provide a great opportunity for interacting with, and learning from, other students who are often engaged in different roles in the legal services industry.

The course is based on the IILPM's 4-Phase LPM Framework. This Framework begins by focusing on essential project management ideas and techniques but then covers much more. The result is a comprehensive approach to legal service delivery.

## 4-PHASE LPM FRAMEWORK



### Course Deliverables

1. Written notes covering all topics referred to in each module.
2. IILPM approved Templates for executing key tasks found in legal project management.
3. Practical workshops and exercises to help students understand key concepts and develop their legal project management skills.
